

# LUCIANO

The infamous restaurateur Marco Pierre White has just opened a new Italian restaurant in London's St James's Street. Renewing his long standing business relationship with Sir Rocco Forte, their new bar and restaurant opens from lunchtime on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> November.

Luciano, named after Marco's eldest son, is located on the former site of the famed Madame Prunier. Designed by David Collins, the 5,000 sq footage of space is divided into a separate bar and dining room.

The Johnnie Walker Bar is complete with marble mosaic floors, is interspersed with black marble pillars and red leather chaise longues, together with the black marble bar and pewter counter top. This Johnnie Walker Bar will offer a separate shorter dining menu from the restaurant and is also open to non-diners to enjoy the 1930's ambiance and classic cocktails.

Just a few stairs down from the bar, the dining room opens up into another beautiful room with thick oak floors and distressed paintwork on the walls. The round oak tables with the similar red leather covering, help to evoke the circa 1940's era.

Luciano's restaurant will serve 135 covers, the bar seats 70. There is also a private dining area within the restaurant, seating up to 20 people.
